Collection and Use of Personal Data

Mental Network may collect certain Personal Data, among other things, voluntarily provided by yourself. These data are collected when a thought is submitted.

Personal data are information through which you are directly or indirectly identifiable and which are communicated when you use the site. These personal data may include, for example, and are not limited to: your first and last names, your email address, your postal address, your telephone number, etc.

Your personal data are processed in compliance with the legislation in force, including the EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation - GDPR).

Mental Network will only use these data in order to share your thoughts.

Mental Network will retain these data during the period for which they are on show, unless you refuse it.

Security of Personal Data

Mental Network undertakes to employ all technical and legal means to protect personal data, in particular to prevent it from being distorted, damaged or communicated to unauthorised third parties.

If all necessary security measures are implemented in order to secure your data, it cannot however be excluded that an incident will occur when transferring data via e-mail or the Internet.

Use of Cookies

Cookies are used on the website. Cookies are codes in the form of files containing small amounts of information that are downloaded on your computer or another device using a website server. These cookies are directed by your browser to the site on each visit so that it can recognise you as a unique visitor and remember certain information, such as your user preferences.

Each time that you browse the site, information may be collected this way using cookies.

Cookies are used in particular to process statistics and information on traffic, to facilitate browsing and to improve the service for the comfort of the user. When the site requires the use of cookies involving the storage and analysis of personal data, the user's consent must be requested.

By using the site, you therefore agree that cookies are placed on your computer or on your device under the conditions mentioned below.

This consent is valid for a maximum period of 13 months.

You have several options to manage and/or even block cookies. Please note that blocking or deleting cookies, however, may have an impact on your user experience and some parts of the site may no longer be fully accessible.

Different types of cookies can be observed:

- **Necessary cookies:** these allow visitors to use some of the features of the website. If the use of these cookies is disabled, some parts of the website may not function properly. These cookies are only retained for the website visit session.
- **Statistics cookies:** the site uses Google Analytics to understand how each visitor uses the website.
- **Marketing cookies:** these are used to track visitors on the Websites. The intention is to display ads that are relevant and attractive to the individual user, and are therefore more useful for editors and third party advertisers.
